RE: Fountain Pit, Permit NO. M-1982-155, Technical Revision (TR-4), Inert Fill Notice

Dear Mr. Jacoby:

On September 16, 2024, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your 112c Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Technical Revision application for the Fountain Pit, which is located in El Paso County. Preliminary review of the information received determined that the following additional information must be received before the Division can consider your application complete and technical review can begin. Thus, your application is incomplete for the purposes of filing as of September 17, 2024.

1. The Division recognizes that the exact quantity, placement, and nature of import material is unknown at this time. Therefore, the Division requires that the Operator commit to submission of this information as supplemental material to the Fountain Pit's Annual Report each year. Additionally, the Annual Map each year shall show where inert fill was placed within the site. Please respond.

You have thirty (30) days from September 17, 2024 to submit all necessary documents that the Division needs for the application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the thirty day period, the application has not been determined to be complete and filed, the Division may deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items
