## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

Pursuant to Rule 5.03.2(6), the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) has scheduled an informal public hearing for the Cessation Order (CO-2024-001) issued to New Elk Coal Company, LLC (Operator/Permittee) for the Lorencito Canyon Mine, permit no. C-1996-084.

The Lorencito Canyon Mine is a surface coal mine, located approximately 20 miles west of Trinidad, Colorado on State Hwy. 12 in Township 33 and 34 South, Range 66 West, Sections 33 and other un-platted lands on the Hill Ranch. The Hill Ranch is generally located southeast of Weston, Colorado between the South Fork of the Purgatoire River on the west, Highway 12 on

the north, Lorencito Canyon on the east and Little Alamosa Canyon on the south. These lands can be located on the USGS 7.5 minute Little Pine topographical quadrangle map. The hearing will consider the Cessation Order issued to the Operator for failing to abate

Violation No. CV-2024-001. The informal public hearing has been set to begin at 1:00 PM on Monday September 23, 2024, and will be conducted virtually.
