Dear Mr. Newby,

The Division has completed an initial review of the materials submitted with the Technical Revision No. 4 (TR-4) application. Please review the following comments and address the items in bold.

TR-4 was submitted in response to the Division's inspection report of July 15, 2024, which requested that a revision be submitted to update and clarify the reclamation plan. A deadline of September 16, 2024 was set; the TR-4 application was submitted in good time.

- A copy of the Eagle County Special Use Permit was included with the TR-4 application; however, no update was made to Exhibit E of the Mining Permit, which describes the Reclamation Plan. The plan described in the Mining Permit will need to comply with the terms of the Eagle County SUP (and vice versa), but the two permits are separate.
 Please submit a revised version of Exhibit E of the Mining Permit to describe the Reclamation Plan, in accordance with Rule 6.4.5.
- Exhibit F of the Mining Permit is the Reclamation Plan Map. It must show the postmining land use of all land within the permit area, and the post-mining topography.
 Please submit a revised version of Exhibit F – Reclamation Plan Map, in accordance with Rule 6.4.6.

The decision due date for TR-4 is September 12, 2024. Please request an extension to this date that will give you sufficient time to respond to this adequacy review.
