On July 16, 2024, the Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (Division/DRMS) filed for review your Acreage Reduction request (AR-1) submitted for JH Sand & Gravel Pit #1, permitted by JH Sand & Gravel, LLC. Upon review of your request, the Division has identified the following items the require further clarification and/or information:

1. An inspection of the operation was conducted by the Division in accordance with Rule 4.17.2(2) on August 21, 2024. At the time of the inspection there was some land disturbances and equipment present on the land owned by Gerald and Norma Korinek (proposed for release). Mr. Korinek was present during the time of the inspection and when asked about the disturbances and equipment, he stated that the equipment is his own and that he did not want any further reclamation on his property to take place.
2. Please provide a signed written statement from Gerald and Norma Korinek addressing the equipment and any mining related disturbances on their property. The purpose of the letter is to show that the landowner is satisfied with the state of their land after mining and reclamation operations by the operator and that there are no unresolved environmental issues.
