Dear Mr. Disckson,

The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (the Division) has finished reviewing the 2024 3rd Quarter Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs). The Division finds the reports to be in compliance with the following Rules:

- **Rule 4.05.13(2)(i)** – Samples are measured accurately and record the quality and quantity of the water discharged from the permit area.
- **Rule 4.05.13(2)(ii)** – There are three outfalls associated with the COG850001 permit; Outfall 001, Outfall 002 and Outfall 003. During the months of July, August and September Outfalls 001, 002 and 003 did not discharge. Therefore, no exceedances occurred.
- **Rule 4.05.13(2)(iii)** – Discharge Monitoring Reports are received on a quarterly basis and filed with the Division within 90 days of the sample collection. The 3rd Quarter DMRs were submitted on October 9, 2024.
