Dear Mr. Lennberg:

On behalf of Holcim-WCR, Inc. (Holcim), this letter provides the information requested in the October 10, 2024 DRMS Adequacy Review No. 1 letter for TR-3 of Wattenberg Lakes Permit No. M-2004-051. As requested, the following updated information is provided to further clarify the total disturbed area permitted/approved for mining versus total disturbed area <u>not</u> permitted for mining:

- Total Permit Area = 420.8 acres
- Affected Area = 420.8 acres
- Disturbed Area (permitted/approved for mining) = 242.2 acres (previously disturbed by mining or to be disturbed by mining)
- Disturbed Area (outside of approved mining, <u>not</u> permitted for mining) = 119.8 acres (road access, staging areas, conveyor belt corridors, etc.)
- Undisturbed Area = 58.8 acres

These acreages are consistent with the areas shown on the Amendment 1 (AM-1) F-1 Reclamation Plan Map.
