**Re: Past Due Monitoring Compliance, Annual Groundwater Level Data for 2024,
Goose Haven Reservoir #2 – Complex Expansion, Permit No. M-2010-071**

Dear Ms. Asquith:

On October 15, 2024, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received your annual report, map and fee for the Goose Haven Reservoir #2 – Complex Expansion. However, as part of the approved permit the Operator committed to providing quarterly groundwater level monitoring data every year with submission of the annual report. The Operator did not submit the required monitoring information with the 2024 annual report.

Please provide the missing groundwater level monitoring data along with the supporting tables, maps, and graphs.

In reviewing the annual report, the Division noted that in the submission the Operator indicated that Fritz Sprague is the Permittee Contact. Is Mr. Sprague still the correct contact person? The Division understood that he was no longer employed by the city, since 2023. If he is no longer the correct contact person, then the information needs to be updated with the correct contact information.

For question #21, “Does your permit require you to submit monitoring information annually?”, the Operator marked “No”. The answer to this question is incorrect. Please provide a statement revising your answer to this question.
