Mr. Simmons,

We no longer own the Robert Fulton property. When it was sold years ago, we did not retain an access easement to the mine dump or any rights to mine the dump material there.

The current property owner is not willing to provide us with information on the structures he intends to build, nor to allow us to survey his property, nor is he willing to provide demonstration to us that he is compliant with local land use and zoning laws; and (reasonably) states that it is none of our business.

We have never conducted any activity on that site. No ore has been mined, removed, or even disturbed by us or anyone working for/with us at that site.

We request an extension at this time, since the corrective actions are outside our legal authority, and to discuss with you the possibility of rescinding the permit and releasing the associated cash bond to us as we have never commenced any mining activity at the site.
