## Re: Korwell Dirt, File No. M-2022-034, Receipt of Amendment No. 1 (AM-1) Application Package, Incompleteness Notice

Dear Craig Rasmuson:

On November 6, 2024, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety ("Division" or "Office") received your request for Amendment of 112c Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Application Package (AM-1) for the Korwell Dirt, File No. M-2022-034. A preliminary review of the information received determined that the following information must be received before the Division can consider your application as being submitted and technical review can begin. Thus, your application is incomplete for the purposes of filing as of November 21, 2024.

## **Application Form:**

- 1. Pages 2 and 3, and pages 5 through 8 of the Application Form were not included in the Application submission. Please submit these pages.
- 2. Item #3 of the application form states the permit acreage would be 132 acres. This would indicate the reduction of 30 acres from the current 162-acre permit. In addition, the "Proposed Acreage Revisions" section of the online application form submitted indicates a revised acreage total of 121.50 acres which would be a release of 40.5 acres of permitted and affected area. Be advised, an applicant cannot release permitted or affected area through the Amendment process. Please revise the Amendment Application form with the incompleteness items noted in this letter. This includes keeping the permitted acreage at 162 acres for Item #3 of the form. If and when this amendment application is approved and once the post-mine land use of the area the Applicant is desiring to release is established, the Applicant can submit an Acreage Release application to release the desired area.

## Notice Sign Affidavit:

**3.** You must post sufficient Notices at the location of the mine site to clearly identify the site and to provide notice of the submittal of the application in accordance with Rule 1.6.2(1)(b). Please provide the signed affidavit included with the 112c application certifying the required sign(s) have been posted.

# **Exhibit Q- Proof of Mailing Notices to Board of County Commissioners and Conservation District:**

In accordance with Rule 1.6.2(1)(a)(ii), the notice must be on the form approved by the Mined Land Reclamation Board as provided in the 112c application materials. Proof of notice to the Board of County Commissioners for Weld County can be accomplished in the form of a return receipt of a certified mailing or a date-stamped copy of the notice acknowledging receipt by the appropriate local Board.

#### Exhibit R: Proof of Filing with County Clerk and Recorder:

7. In accordance with Rule 6.4.18, please submit a revised Exhibit R that includes an affidavit or receipt indicating the date on which the application was placed with the local County Clerk and Recorder for public review, pursuant to Rule1.6.2(1)(c).

You have sixty (60) days from November 21, 2024 to submit all necessary documents that the Division needs for the application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, the application has not been determined to be complete and filed, the Division may deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
