As you are aware, we have addressed the 'Signs and Markers' action item. The City has a draft weed control plan and are working on coordination with the local county extension agency (Colorado State University). The City also has a signed contract with Civil Resources to incorporate this weed control plan, and other items identified in the report, through a Technical Revision.
