

PUBLIC NOTICE: The City of Lamar, 102 E. Parmenter St., Lamar, CO 81052, (719) 336-2002, has filed an amendment for an existing Construction Materials Limited Impact (110) Mined Land Reclamation Board under provisions of the Colorado Land Reclamation Act for the Extraction of Construction Materials. The mine is known as the Lamar Park Gravel Pit (File No. M-1987-078) and is located at or near Section 20, Township 22 South, Range 46 West of the 6th Principal Meridian. The proposed amendment changes the future use of the mine to industrial/commercial to match the current use of the surrounding properties.
