On November 12, 2024, the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety ("DRMS" or "Division") received your 112c Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Application package for the Farmers Sand, File No. M-2024-057. The Division sent a Notice of Incompleteness letter on November 25, 2024, and on December 4, 2024 the Division received a response submitted by Ecological Resource Consultants, LLC to the Notice of Incompleteness letter. Review of the information received determined that the following additional item must be addressed before the Division can consider your application as being submitted and technical review can begin.

Exhibit Q:

1. The Applicant included documentation that indicates the entire permit application has been sent to the Platte Valley Conservation District, and revised pages of the permit application were sent to the West Greeley Conservation District. In accordance with Rule 6.4.17 and Rule 1.6.2(1)(a)(ii), please submit a revised Exhibit Q that includes only proof of notice of the permit application on a form approved by the Board (attached), not the permit application itself, was sent to the Platte Valley Conservation District. Proof of notice to the Conservation District can be accompanied in the form of a return receipt of certified mailing or a date-stamped copy of the notice acknowledging receipt by the appropriate conservation board.

Your application will not be considered submitted until all the information listed above is received and found sufficient to begin our review.

You have sixty (60) days from the above date to submit all necessary documents that the Office needs for an application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, the application has been not been determined to be filed with the Office, the Office may



deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
