Dear Dustin Hribar:

On December 13, 2024, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your responses to the Division's Incompleteness Notice No. 1 sent in response to receiving the initial Amendment no. 1 (AM1) application package materials for the Peak View Pit, File No. M-2014-028. Preliminary review of the information received determined that <u>the following additional information must be received/corrected</u> before the Division can consider your application as being submitted and technical review can begin:

Application Form

- 1. <u>On page six of the application:</u>
 - Item #10 requires a signature <u>for joint venture/partnership operators</u>. On the originally submitted version of this page, the Applicant had put "N/A" as their entry. On the re-submitted page, the Applicant initialed this item.
 - * Please clarify to the Division which option is correct. If the original page is correct, the Division will disregard the resubmitted page. If it's the latter, the re-submitted page will replace the original.
- 2. <u>On the certification page (page eight of the Application):</u>
 - The signature line for the County Clerk has been left blank.
 - * Please either write "No Seal" or obtain the County Clerk's signature, renotarize, and resubmit the page.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS OF EXHIBITS

6.2.1 General Requirements

(1) This Rule provides for the guidelines for, and information requirements of, each Exhibit required to be submitted with the permit application, as specified according to Rule 6.1.

(2) Maps and Exhibits Maps, except the index map, must conform to the following criteria: (a) show name of Applicant; (b) must be prepared and signed by a registered land surveyor, professional engineer, or other qualified person; (c) give date prepared; (d) identify and outline the area which corresponds with the application; (e) with the exception of the map of the affected lands required in Section 34-32.5-112(2)(d), C.R.S. 1984, as amended, shall be prepared at a scale that is appropriate to clearly show all elements that are required to be delineated by the Act and these Rules. The acceptable range of map scales shall not be larger than 1 inch = 50 feet nor smaller than 1 inch = 660 feet. Also, that a map scale, appropriate legend, map title, date and a north arrow shall be included.
