### **COMMENTS**

This report documents the Division's observations taken during a complete inspection of the Fruita No. 1 and 2 Mine, Permit No. C-1981-015. The inspection was conducted on December 18, 2024 by Clayton Wein of the Division. The Fruita No. 1 and 2 Mine is a revoked mine site, therefore no company representative was present for the inspection. The weather was clear with a temperature of 46° F. The ground conditions were mostly dry with some muddy areas.

Access to the Fruita No. 1 and 2 Mine is obtained by following 18 Road to the base of the Bookcliffs. During the inspection 18 Road was closed for repairs and maintenance. The Fruita No. 1 and 2 Mine was not able to be accessed (Photo 1). The Division inspects the mine site quarterly. The Division will conduct a routine monitoring inspection in the first quarter of 2025 once the 18 Road maintenance is complete.
