Dear Mr. Bear:

The Division has completed an adequacy review of Minor Revision No. 208 (MR-208). The following items must be addressed before we can approve this revision.

1. On Map 01, it appears that there is no parcel for landowners Leonard and Dinah Wiggins (#05 in the landowner key) on the map. Please explain why they are listed in the key if they do not own land in the permit area. Also, please check for other inconsistencies between the map and the key and revise the map, as necessary.
2. It appears that the issue with access agreements was not addressed with the MR-208 application. BRL should state if new agreements were needed and provide them as a revision to the PAP (e.g., Exhibit 25 of Volume IIIB), as necessary, in your response to this adequacy letter.
