## **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted by Ben Hammar as a representative of the Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety as part of the Division's standard monitoring program. The CLG Farms Pit is an 8.66 acre 110c construction materials permit located approximately 5.5 miles southwest of Akron, Colorado. The operator was not present at the inspection, and at the time of inspection the sky was cloudy and the ground was dry.

The site identification sign was present at the mine entrance, and the site boundary was clearly marked with all disturbance being within bounds. The site was active at the time of inspection, and a single excavator was present in the pit stockpiling material. Only one excavated area was present with an access road connecting to the southern portion of the pit. Vertical highwalls were present around the perimeter of the pit. A large seeded topsoil pile was present along the western boundary which appeared well-maintained and stable. No water related issues were present, and as mentioned the site was dry at the time of this inspection.

The current bond held by the Division for this site is \$26,500. During the review process of this permit, it has come to the Division's attention that this bond has not been updated since 2012. Due to this, the currently held surety is likely inadequate to reclaim this site. The Division will reach out with a separate notification with a draft surety increase following the submission of this report.
