Dear Mr. Carpenter:

On December 19th, 2024 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received a response to a Notice of Incompleteness to the Application Form for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators from WW Clyde & Co to Western Slope Materials, LLC for the Rifle Gravel Pit #1, Permit M-2021-052. The following items are incomplete for the application to be processed:

Structure Agreement

1. All structure agreements provided within the application package are incomplete. Completed Structure Agreements are required for all permanent man-made structures and utilities within 200 feet of the affected lands. One agreement per structure owner with all features (structures) listed. If an agreement cannot be obtained than a Geo-tech may be provided, see Rules 6.3.12 and 6.4.19.

Please return the required documentation to the Division **before March 16, 2025**. All completed permit documents are required to be submitted for consideration of your Request for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators Application. An incomplete application may be denied after the 60 day submittal request, if requested documents or information are not received. In the event of any delay in your submittal or if you have any questions, please contact the Division.
