COMMENTS:

Northern Colorado Constructors, Inc. has submitted a request for a surety reduction for the permitted area of the Perry Pit, Permit No. M-1990-098. The Perry Pit is primarily located in



the NE1/4 of Section 25, Township 1 North, Range 67 West of the 6th P.M. and the NW1/4 of the NW1/4 of Section 30, Township 1 North, Range 66 West, of the 6th P.M., and contains one lined pond, designated as Perry Pit Reservoir (WDID 0203503). The reservoir was lined with a soil bentonite slurry wall. The slurry wall liner was approved on June 9, 2006 as meeting the design standard referenced in the August 1999 State Engineer Guidelines for Lining Criteria for Gravel Pits.

Based on the above the State Engineer's Office has no concerns regarding the requested surety reduction for Perry Pit, provided water shall not be impounded in the reservoir except pursuant to lawful diversions allowed by statute or decree. At all other times, all inflow of water into the reservoir from any source, including precipitation and groundwater inflows, shall be removed by the Applicant.
