The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) has further reviewed your Notice of Intent to Prospect (NOI) submitted on October 15, 2024, and determined that the Division does not have primacy over the drilling project you proposed in your request submitted on October 15, 2024. Regulatory authority over Geothermal Resources is assigned to Colorado Energy and Carbon Management Commission (ECMC). The Division cannot authorize this project due to it being outside of the scope and jurisdiction of the Division's Rules and Regulations. Therefore, your request for P-2024-013 is **denied**.

The ECMC has exclusive jurisdiction over Deep Geothermal Operations (C.R.S. 37-90.5-106(1)(b)(I)) and Deep Geothermal Operations include the *exploration for* and production of Allocated Geothermal Resources (See, C.R.S. 37-90.5-103(3)). Please contact ECMC for permitting and other requirements related to the exploration and development of Geothermal Resources.
