2024 Annual Reclamation Report

Dear Mr. Simmons,

Please accept this letter as the 2024 Annual Reclamation Report for the Oxbow Mining, LLC, Terror Creek loadout facility.

During 2024, reclamation activities included removal of powerline and poles that supplied the Loadout Facilities Substation. Concrete pads, fencing and other structure was removed from the substation area as well.

The coal sorting and loadout facility equipment was dismantled and removed from the property prior to 2017. Railroad track and ties, associated with the sidings used to load coal cars in the past, were removed from the property during 2017 and the ballast was left in place. The Union Pacific Rail Road (UPRR) continues to store rock in this area, which is in the right of way. The Shower facility was inspected and no asbestos was found. The Shower facility was then demolished and removed to the Delta County Landfill during late 2019. During October of 2020, remaining concrete structures of the main production level were removed and buried in preparation to pursue the commercial post mine land use.

During 2023, Oxbow made progress toward achieving the post mine land use, per Minor Revision 33, as a multiuse storage facility, that will accommodate construction materials such as sand, gravel, and heavy equipment in addition to storage of RV's and Boats. In 2023 a Fabric Building, 85'x 240'x 50,'was assembled and stored sand, and in 2024, was again used for sand storage by Gunnison Energy, LLC. Sand storage is expected to happen again in 2025 and beyond.

Coal fines and concrete pedestals and rail ballast located to the south of the main production level, along the UPRR right of way, were removed and buried during 2023. No topsoil was disturbed during 2024. Straw waddles were installed to provide sediment control in this industrial use area.

The property was spot sprayed for minor invasions of the noxious weeds whitetop (*cardaria draba*) and Canada thistle (Cirsium arvense), using Crossbow and Escort herbicides in accordance with the requirements of the labels.

Attached is an executed CDRMS Annual Reclamation Report for the year 2024 form, as required for Division records.
