The Division has received and reviewed the 2024 December and the quarterly Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs), including the chronic WET testing results for the Trapper Mine. The DMRs were received electronically by the Division on 17 January 2025. Thank you for your timely submittal of this information. Trapper submits DMRs to the Division, in accordance with Rule 4.05.13(2)(a)(iii).

Trapper reported the following outfalls discharged during the month:

- Johnson #10 NPDES 001
- No Name Pond #5 NPDES 002
- East Pyeatt #2 NPDES 011

During the quarter all above mentioned ponds discharged as did:

- Middle Flume Gulch..NPDES 20
- East Middle Flume NPDES 021

Trapper reported that none of the outfalls requiring chronic WET testing discharged. DMRs for discharging outfalls indicated no exceedences of paramaters.
