This gravel pit pond is currently permitted under permit no. 57737-F. However, the pond shall not be operated unless it is included in a substitute water supply plan approved by the State Engineer or a plan for augmentation approved by the Water Court.

COMMENTS:

DWR records indicate this gravel pit is in the W ½ of the SE ¼ of Section 22, and the NE ¼ of the NE ¼ of Section 27, Township 38N, Range 14 W of the New Mexico P.M., which includes more sections than indicated within the application's location information.
