Dear Vic Girardi:

On January 29, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your 112c Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Surety Release Request application for the Hidden Pit. Preliminary review of the information received determined that the application form must be revised before the Division can consider your application complete and technical review can begin. Thus, your application is incomplete for the purposes of filing as of January 31, 2025.

The official owner of record of the affected land for Permit No. M-2022-040 is Hidden Mesa Ranch LLC. The name and address for this company should be the only owner of record listed on page 2 of the application form.

You have thirty (30) days from January 31, 2025 to submit all necessary documents that the Division needs for the application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the 30-day period, the application has not been determined to be complete and filed, the Division may deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
