Exhibit C - Mining plan:

Quarrying will occur when a specific color and texture of stone is needed. Indio #1 location is where material will be processed and stored until it needs to be shipped. Indio #1 has a small building with a scale where all material is weighed. There are several access roads for equipment to access the quarries for moving material and cleaning quarries.

Exhibit D - Reclamation plan:

As pits are mined/quarried out they will be reclaimed.

Building/storage areas will be graded flat.

Pits will be backfilled. High walls will be graded to 3:1.

Stone being stored on Indio # 2 is the property of the landowner and will remain on the property for personal use; it will not be sold.

All access roadways will remain open after reclamation.

Seeding of grasses will take place as reclamation progresses and will consist of native bunch grass seed. Grass seed will be applied by hand or with a spreader. Trees will reproduce naturally as they have done in the past. These trees consist of ponderosa pine and rocky mountain juniper.
