Dear Mr. Takami,

On January 31, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received the 4th Quarter 2024 Groundwater, Mine Effluent, Surface Water and Treatment Plant Effluent Quality Report for the Cross Gold Mine, Permit No. M-1977-410. After review of the submission the Division has additional items that need to be addressed or clarified.

1. During review the Division noted the copper concentration measured in the Caribou Well, 3.4 mg/l, exceeded the regulatory standard of 0.2 mg/l. This exceedance is higher than previous exceedances measured at this location. Please provide a time series graph of copper concentrations measured in the Caribou Well since 2022. Include on the graph the regulatory standard.
2. Please provide a discussion on why copper periodically exceeds the regulatory standard at the Caribou Well. Include in the discussion what mining or site activities that may be contributing to the exceedances.

Please respond to these items within 30 days of the date on this letter, by **March 6, 2025**. The Division reserves the right to further supplement this document with additional items and details as necessary
