Re: Gunnison River Gravel Pits - File No. M-2009-048 CW Construction, LLC Surety Reduction Request (SR-1) Surety Reduction

Dear Cody Weaver:

On February 21, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety considered your request for a surety reduction. The Division found the site is not eligible for a reduction in surety and denied this request. The Division estimates the total site liability to be \$152,403 which is more than the currently held Financial Warranty of \$91,664. A Surety Reduction cannot be considered until settling associated with Pit 5 is resolved. Given that the compliance due date to correct the slope settling issues would be due before a potential surety increase, the Division will wait to adjust the financial warranty until the settling matter is resolved.

In accordance with Rule 1.4.11, any person who can demonstrate that they are directly and adversely affected or aggrieved by an action of the Office, may petition for a hearing before the Board on such action within thirty (30) days of the date of the Office decision, if the decision was a denial, without a hearing. Such petitions for a hearing shall state how the petitioner is directly and adversely affected or aggrieved by the Office's decision, and how the petitioner's interests are entitled to protection under the Act. The petitioner shall list and explain any issue the petitioner believes should be considered by the Board at the hearing on the matter. The petition for a hearing shall specify the application or file number assigned by the Office.
