## Re: Alamosa Pit No.2, Permit No. M-1983-175 Technical Revision (TR-1), Preliminary Adequacy Review

Mr. Bottini:

On February 19, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received the Technical Revision (TR-1) application for the Alamosa Pit No.2, permit number M-1983-175. Based on review of the material submitted, the Division has identified the following items must be addressed before the TR-1 application can be approved. Please submit a cover letter responding to the item listed below.

- 1. The Operator indicated quarterly documentation of treatment activities, environmental conditions, and vegetation response would be effective. However, the application stated that annual reporting will be submitted the Division. Given the severity of the noxious weed infestation at the site, please commit to submitting quarterly reporting of the results of the Weed Mitigation Plan.
- 2. Please include list of all potential weed species to be treated. The Division observed Tamarisk and Russian olive during the inspection conducted on September 5, 2024, however these noxious were not mentioned in the application. The applicant should consult with Alamosa County regarding this list.
- 3. On page 6 of the TR-1 application, Operator included a site map. Please revise the figure to include a legend that clarifies what the red, blue, and green shaded areas correspond to. In addition, please revise this map pursuant to Rule 6.2.1(2).

Please note the Division is required to issue a decision regarding the TR-1 application by **March 21**, **2025**. If you cannot address the above issue before the decision date, please request an extension of the decision date to ensure adequate time for the Division to review material. If any adequacy issues remain by the decision date, the Division may deny your request.
