RE: Hayden Gulch Loadout; C-1992-081; 2024 Annual Reclamation Report Review

Dear Ms. Kawcak:

The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (Division) has received and reviewed the 2024 Annual Reclamation Reports (ARR) for the Hayden Gulch Loadout for compliance with Rule 2.04.13. Below is a discussion of the Division's review.

Rule 2.04.13(1) – The ARR was received by the Division on February 13, 2025.

Rule 2.04.13(1)(a) – The cover of the ARR Form includes the name of the permittee, the address and the permit number.

Rule 2.04.13(1)(b) - The report indicates there were a cumulative total of 202.1 acres disturbed at the mine site. There were 0.0 acres of new disturbance in the calendar year of 2024. The total acreage approved to be disturbed in 2024 at the Foidel Creek Mine is 202.1 acres.

Rule 2.04.13(1)(C) – The report indicated that 0.0 acres were backfilled and graded in 2024. The cumulative total reported 14.2 acres backfilled and graded.

Rule 2.04.13(1)(d) – The report indicated that 0.0 acres were topsoiled in 2024. The cumulative total reported 14.2 acres topsoiled.

2.04.13(1)(e) – The report indicated that 0.0 acres were revegetated in 2024. The total acreage reseeded at the mine site is 14.2 acres. 2.04.13(1)(f) – A total of 14.2 acres have been reseeded prior to 2024.

2.04.13(2) – Additional documentation provided with the 2024 ARR included a cover letter.

The Division does not have any additional questions at this time.

It is noted that the Division interprets the submittal date of February 15, or other such date as agreed on identified per Rule 2.04.13(1) as the complete and accurate submittal of the Annual Reclamation Report covering the previous calendar year for all areas under bond.
