On March 12, 2025 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety concluded its review of the Technical Revision application submitted to the Division on February 3, 2025, addressing the following:

Revise reclamation plan to change depth of topsoil to be replaced from an average of 12 inches to an average of 6 inches and remove mulch application.

The decision reached by the Division is: approve.

The terms of Technical Revision No. 4 approved by the Division are hereby incorporated into Permit No. M-1997-086. All other conditions and requirements of Permit No. M-1997-086 remain in full force and effect.

The revised liability amount exceeds the financial warranty currently held (see below). The Division will issue a separate Surety Increase. The Permittee will have sixty (60) days from the date of the Surety Increase to post the additional required financial surety.
