Mr. Absmeier:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received the above-referenced Technical Revision application on January 30, 2025. A revised Weed Management Plan was sent on March 14, 2025. Based on review of the material submitted, the Division has identified the following item must be addressed before the Technical Revision application can be approved. Please submit a cover letter responding to the item listed below.

1. Based on the well-established native vegetation in the pit, the Division notes that using a box-blade and road grader to mechanically remove noxious weeds may negatively affect the desired vegetation in the pit. Please revise the mechanical treatment to use a more targeted approach that will minimally impact the desired vegetation observed in the pit.
2. Please request an extension of the decision date in order to address the deficiencies in the Weed Management Plan. This can be accomplished via email.
