Dear Tonya,

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (the Division) has completed its review of the 2022 and 2023 Annual Reclamation Reports (ARR) for the Roadside Portals Mine. The Division finds the reports in compliance with the following Rules:

2.04.13(1) – The 2022 ARR was received by the Division on February 2, 2023. The 2023 ARR was received by the Division on February 2, 2024.

2.04.13(1)(a) – The cover of the 2022 and 2023 ARRs included the name of the permittee, the address and the permit number.

2.04.13(1)(b) – The reports indicate that a cumulative total of 241.9 acres have been disturbed at the mine site. There were 0.0 acres of disturbance created in the calendar year of 2022. There were 0.0 acres of disturbance created during the 2023 calendar year.

2.04.13(1)(c) – The report indicated that 0.0 acres were backfilled and graded in 2022 and 2023. The cumulative total reported for both years was 230.4 acres for the backfilled and graded field.

2.04.13(1)(d) – The report listed 0.0 acres were topsoiled in 2022 and 2023. The cumulative total reported 132.0 acres for the topsoiled category.

2.04.13(1)(e) – The report indicated that 0.0 acres were revegetated in 2022. The Roadside Portals Mine is nearing the completion of all reclamation activities. 0.4 acres of disturbance remain permitted and have not achieved Phase III Bond Release. These acres were associated with the approved activities under Technical Revision No. 69. The activities approved under TR-69 were completed in the fall of 2019. In October of 2023, the surface owner bladed the



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vegetation on the 0.4 acres. The operator reseeded the acreage following the activities of the surface owner. The 2023 ARR noted that 0.4 acres were reseeded as indicated in the Acres Seeded 9 Years or Less category.

2.04.13(1)(f) – A total of 157.5 acres have been reseeded as of the end of 2022. The total of 157.5 acres carried over to the 2023 ARR.

2.04.13(2) – Additional documentation provided with the 2022 and 2023 ARRs included a map showing the record of reclamation activities at the Roadside Mine, a summary of the reclamation at the mine site, and a copy of the seed mix tag used for the reclaimed areas.
