Rob,

We greatly appreciate the Division's willingness to work with us and accept the revisions proposed in your February letter. At this point we do not plan on submitting anything further than we already have. We would still like the Division to consider using alternative equipment cost references and it sounds like other operators in the state feel the same way. It is disappointing that other options cannot be considered simply because it is only updated in Circes on an annual basis. Perhaps the Division is willing to consider the use of Mine and Mill or other cost references in the future, and we would be willing to work with you to provide whatever information would be helpful to gather a reasonably foreseeable cost scenario.

We are currently working with our bonding broker to determine our surety options and consulting with other operators to determine if there is anything else we can do in the future to avoid such a large change over such a short period of time. If you have any further suggestions, we would appreciate them as well.
