On March 21, 2025, the Division received the request for a Technical Review (TR-4) for the Keenesburg No. 2 Mine, File No. M-2019-058, seeking approval and authorization for the installation of water storage tanks located on 4.9 acres within the processing plant area. During review of the material submitted, the Division determined that the following items need to be addressed before TR-4 can be considered for approval.

Rule 6.4.4- Exhibit D- Mining Plan:

1. Please update figure D-1 to indicate the location of the water storage tanks on the map and within the Symbol Legend.

Rule 6.4.6- Exhibit F- Reclamation Plan Map:

2. Please update figure F-1 to indicate the location of the water storage tanks on the map and within the Symbol Legend. In addition, please include footnotes indicating the water storage tanks were constructed for non-mining purposes and will not be removed during reclamation activities.

This concludes the Division's adequacy review of TR-4. Please be advised TR-4 may be deemed inadequate, and the request may be denied on **April 20, 2025**, unless the adequacy review items are addressed to the satisfaction of the Division. If more time is needed to respond, the Division can grant an extension of the decision date following a request to do so by the Operator.
