Hi Nikie:

Please find the attached notification letter with map for a slight exceedance of the site-specific GW standard for Manganese reported during the 1st Quarter 2025 sampling event in POC well MW-4 at Chavers. The Manganese concentration reported in well MW-4 was **0.4032 mg/L** which only slightly exceeds the site-specific groundwater quality standard (i.e., **0.397 mg/L**) by **0.0062 mg/L**. As this is within the general range of previous concentrations reported, I believe this is just a temporary fluctuation in the area. I will collect a confirmation sample and send the results along with a graph of previous Manganese results once they are received. Please let me know if you have any questions.

Re: Notification of Groundwater Exceedance during the 1st Quarter 2025 Sampling Event at Chavers Mining Resource (DRMS Permit No. M-2015-030)

Ms. Gagnon:

Asphalt Specialties Co., Inc. (ASCI) is submitting this letter as notification of an exceedance in groundwater reported for Manganese above the site-specific groundwater quality standard of 0.397 mg/L in Point of Compliance (POC) well MW-4 during the 1st Quarter 2025 sampling event at Chavers (conducted at the end of March 2025). The concentration reported for Manganese in well MW-4 was 0.4032 mg/L which only slightly exceeds the site-specific groundwater quality standard by 0.0062 mg/L. The location of MW-4 is shown in Attachment A.

Historically, Manganese has previously been detected at similar elevated concentrations in upgradient monitoring wells MW-2 (i.e., 0.397 mg/L in September 2023) and MW-3 (i.e., 0.3679 mg/L in December 2024). To verify the 1st Quarter 2025 result, ASCI will collect a confirmation sample from MW-4 for Manganese in April 2025. Once the confirmation results are received, ASCI will submit the data to DRMS along with a graph of quarterly Manganese concentrations reported and discuss any trends identified.
