Initial Review of the SL-04 Application (Second incompleteness letter)**

Dear Mr. Etter:

I previously sent a letter stating that the SL-04 application is incomplete (on April 15, 2025). The following additional issues regarding the SL-04 submittal must be addressed before the Division can call the application complete:

1. Per a Division guideline ("Guideline Regarding Selected Coal Mine Bond Release Issues," 1995), a bond release application must include maps illustrating the areas related to the application. However, the SL-04 application does not include maps showing the Terror Creek fan site or the applicable gob vent boreholes.
2. Per Rule 3.03.2(1), a bond release application must include copies of notices to surface owners. However, the SL-04 application does not include a notice to Legacy Ranches, LLC, which is the owner of the land where the gob vent boreholes are located.
