**Re: Additional Information Required, Annual Groundwater Data for 2024-2025,
Section 20 Gravel Mine, Permit No. M-2022-001**

Dear Mr. Regan:

On April 9, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received the Annual Groundwater Data for 2024-2025 from the Section 20 Gravel Mine. After review of the submission the Division has additional items that need to be addressed or clarified.

1. Please provide a monitoring well location map that shows the locations of all eight monitoring wells relative to the permit boundary.
2. The currently approve monitoring plan specifies that analytical samples will be collected from MW-2 and MW-5. However, the data provided includes analytical results for wells MW-1 and MW-3. Please provide an explanation for the additional data. It is noted that during TR-1 the permittee committed to updating the groundwater monitoring plan through a Technical Revision prior to submitting the results of the baseline groundwater monitoring data and prior to exposing groundwater at the site.
3. The analytical tables provided are titled the same but contain different results. Please update and resubmit the tables.
4. Please provide a brief statement regarding the reason for the Nitrate exceedances in MW-2 and MW-3.

Please respond to these items by **May 18, 2025**. The Division reserves the right to further supplement this document with additional items and details as necessary.
