On April 17, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received the First Quarter 2025 Groundwater and Surface Water Monitoring Report for the Cash & Who Do Mines. After review of the submission the Division has the following comment.

At this time the Division does not consider the First Quarter 2025 monitoring data to have been collected in accordance with the approved Water Monitoring Plan and committed to by the Operator/Permittee in TR-5, approved on April 9, 2007. Failure to follow the approved permit or conditions of permit and failure to demonstrate there is no unauthorized release of pollutants to groundwater are subject to enforcement actions by the Division.
