Adequacy Review of 2024 Annual Reclamation Report**

Dear Ben:

I have performed a review of your 2024 Annual Reclamation Report (ARR), which you submitted on March 14, 2025. The table with acreage values (page 309) appears to be accurate and current. Also, the ARR map appears to be accurate and current.

I do have two adequacy items:

1. On page 307, more explanation is needed for the value of 225.1 acres. Does this include undisturbed areas and the permanent features (ponds and facility area)? If so, the description in the text should be revised, because these areas have not been revegetated or otherwise reclaimed.
2. On page 312, the description for Permit Revision Number 3 should be revised to "Add Industrial/Commercial Post-Mining Land Use."

Please submit revised pages to the Division with a cover letter stating that you are providing a response to this adequacy review letter.
