Dear Bryce A. Bohl:

On April 8, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your 110c Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Conversion application for the Meadow Hollow Quarry, which is located in Larimer County. A preliminary review of the information received determined that the following additional information must be received before the Division can consider your application complete and technical review can begin. Thus, your application is incomplete for the purposes of filing as of April 21, 2025.

1. Item 5.1 Incidental commodity(ies) to be mined of the application form is given as "Road Base"; this is an end use item, please specify what earth material will be extracted (i.e. sand, gravel).
2. Item 10 Primary Mine Entrance Location of the application form gives the longitude of 106 degrees, 13 minutes, and 10.21 seconds which appears to be inaccurate. The longitude coordinates provided in Exhibit A: Legal Description do appear to be accurate.

You have sixty (60) days from April 21, 2025, to submit all necessary documents that the Division needs for the application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty-day period, the application has not been determined to be complete and filed, the Division may deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
