I am writing in response to your letter of April 21st requesting additional information with respect to Colorado Quarry 1, LLC's (the "**Applicant**") "Construction Material Regular (112) Operation Reclamation Permit Application" (the "**Application**"). Specifically, you have requested additional information regarding Items 5.1 and 10 of the Application. Please see our response to your questions below:

Item 5.1. The incidental commodities to be mined include "Road Base." In this case, Road Base is not a primary commodity but is the resulting bi-product of screening and crushing operations with respect to the primary commodities of various grades and sizes of sandstone. In this process sand and gravel which results from or which is naturally contained in the raw sandstone being processed is screened out of those final products. Typically, this results primarily from processing of smaller size stone grades and crushing of ¾" stone gravel. The Road Base does not involve the mining of sand or gravel other than that which is produced by the processing of the primary mined material (sandstone). The Road Base is used for county and dirt road surfaces.

Item 10. The Primary Mine Entrance location is incorrectly stated here as longitude **106** degrees, 13 minutes and 10.21 seconds. This is a typographical error, and the location of the mine entrance is correctly stated in the Exhibit A: Legal Description as longitude **105** degrees, 13 minutes and 10.21 seconds. I have provided a corrected page 2 of the Application reflecting this correct location.

Copies of this correspondence has been delivered to the Larimer County Clerk & Recorder's office to supplement the Applicant's original filing of the Application as required under Rule 1.6.2(1)(c).

I have included with this letter confirmation of the filing of this material with Larimer County Clerk & Recorder to be added to Addendum 1 of the Application.
