<u>RE: Enforcement Abatement Notification, MV-2025-004, Meadow Hollow Quarry, Permit No.</u> <u>M-2009-006</u>

Dear Mr. Bohl,

On April 22, 2025, the Mined Land Reclamation Board (Board) signed the Board's Order for Violation No. MV-2025-004 for failure to protect areas outside of affected land from slides and damage occurring during the mining operation for the Meadow Hollow Quarry, Permit No. M-2009-006. The Board's Order imposed a cease and desist order on the site until corrective actions have been resolved to the satisfaction of the Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (Division/DRMS) and a civil penalty of \$10,750.00 with all but \$500.00 suspended if the Operator complies with the corrective actions within 90 days. The imposed corrective action directs the Operator to submit an amendment application to encompass all of the affected lands.

On April 24, 2025, the conversion application submitted to the Division on April 8, 2025, was complete and filed and the civil penalty fee of \$500.00 was received.

The corrective action is complete, and the Division hereby lifts the cease and desist order.

The Division has abated the enforcement for MV-2025-004.
