On April 25, 2025 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received the Application Form for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators from M.A. Concrete Construction, Inc. to Sunroc Corporation, for the Cole Gravel Pit, Permit M-2004-020. The following items are incomplete for the application to be processed:

Application Form/Fee

1. Incorrect application fee submitted. \$115 was submitted which is the Hard Rock fee amount. This is a Construction Materials site, and the SO fee is \$144. Please submit the remaining \$29.

Financial Warranty

2. Financial Warranty: Page 5 of the submitted form had an error in the notary acknowledgement stating that the county was "County." Please submit a new original page 5 signed by Katlyn Bigelow for Travelers. The Division can accept counterpart signatures so there's no need for Sunroc to sign again.

Misc.

3. Please submit an Affidavit of Authority signed by Mark Wimmer and notarized(attached).



All bonding documents need to be original documents (no photocopies) are accepted. Please be aware that once the request is filed the Division will conduct a site inspection and determine the required Financial Warranty amount. A replacement bond must be submitted prior to the permit being transferred.

Please return the required documentation to the Division **before June 28, 2025**. All completed permit documents are required to be submitted for consideration of your Request for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators Application. An incomplete application may be denied after the 60 day submittal request, if requested documents or information are not received. In the event of any delay in your submittal or if you have any questions, please contact the Division.
