Hello Lexi,

I'm reaching out because you previously provided comments on 1/6/2025 regarding the Farmers Sand/Milton Reservoir 112c permit application, project number M-2024-057. The applicant, The Farmers Reservoir & Irrigation Company (FRICO), recently provided a response to DRMS's Adequacy Review, which includes a direct response to CPW's comments. We are still reviewing FRICO's response to our Adequacy Review letter and would like to keep CPW in the loop.

CPW has noted concerns regarding the installation of a future sand processing plant that could be detrimental to the survival of nests and roosting sites for bald eagles. Attached to this email is a combined pdf of FRICO's memo responding to CPW's Comments, Revised Wildlife Report, and South Side Reclamation Plan Map. FRICO's Adequacy Review Response in its entirety can be viewed on the DRMS Laserfiche Database.
