On May 12, 2025 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety increased the current Financial Warranty for this permit to \$4,843.00, in accordance with Rule 4.2.1 of the Rules and Regulations. This is an increase of \$1,803.00.

Required Financial Warranty increased by \$1,803.00 from \$3,040.00, totaling \$4,843.00.

On May 12, 2025, the Division ordered amendment of the current Financial Warranty or submittal of a new Financial Warranty reflecting the increase, within 60 days.
