OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was performed as a pre-operation inspection in support of DRMS Permit No. M20205018, the Rollins-Clapper Pit. The proposed site is a 9 acre sand and gravel operation located approximately 8 miles southwest of Stratton. This inspection was performed by Ben Hammar, and the weather at the time of inspection was lightly rainy.

The primary purpose of this inspection was to check the appropriate signage was in place as required by DRMS, and to ensure no structures or significant hydrologic features are present near the permit which have not been mentioned in the application.

Regarding the posted notice sign, the sign was observed during this inspection and was found to be in compliance with all Division requirements.

Regarding structures found within 200 feet, two significant structures were found within 200 feet of the permit boundary during this inspection. A fence was found, which the DRMS notice was posted on. In addition, a transmission line runs parallel to the fence. Please provide structure agreement or similar documentation as mentioned in the associated adequacy letter.

No significant hydrological features were observed near the permit boundary, and no other issues were found with the site during this inspection. No bond has been calculated at this time, and a reclamation bond will be calculated by the Division following a response to the first adequacy letter for this site.
