OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Dickerson Pit is located approximately six miles southwest of Gunnison and accessed from Hwy 50. The site is a 112c operation that includes a total of 33.16 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$66,158.00 for this site. The Division will review the reclamation costs in order to ensure the financial warranty reflects the actual current cost of fulfilling the requirements of the Reclamation Plan. The Operator will be notified under separate cover if the Division determines that the current financial warranty amount is insufficient.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by posts that were clearly visible and adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

The current disturbance area covers approximately 15 acres. Mining is progressing towards the north. The highwall spans approximately 700 linear feet, with heights ranging from approximately 40-70 feet, and slopes ranging from approximately 2H:1V to near vertical. Mined material is stockpiled on the bench area below the highwall.

No problems related to stormwater or erosion control were noted. Groundwater has not been exposed at the site. No problems regarding disturbance to the hydrologic balance were noted.

There was no mining or processing equipment stored on site. Fuels were not stored on site. There are no processing facilities on site. Acid generating materials have not been exposed by the operation.

Explosives are not stored on site.

No noxious weed infestations were noted.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
