OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Mountain View Pit is located on the south side of Crested Butte and accessed from a dirt road at the end of 9th Street. The site is a 110c operation that includes a total of 9.1 permitted acres.

Pursuant to Rule 4.1.2, a financial warranty is not required for this site because the Operator is a unit of municipal government.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

The site is in final reclamation. Grading of the highwall is complete. The slope blends well with the surrounding topography, appears stable, and is well vegetated. The flat area at the base of the highwall is currently used by the town of Crested Butte for snow dumping. There is a bike trail that runs through this area.

No problems related to stormwater or erosion control were noted.


There was no equipment or fuel stored on site.

Ground water has not been exposed by the operation. No disturbance of the hydrologic balance was noted.

Acid generating materials have not been exposed by the operation.
