Dear Tyson Geist:

On May 13, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your 111 Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Surety Release Request application for the Diehl Borrow Pit, which is located in Larimer County. A review of the information received determined that the following additional information must be received before the Division can consider your application complete and technical review can begin. Thus, your application is incomplete for the purpose of filing as of May 20, 2025.

The name, address, and phone numbers of all owners of record to the affected land is required, per Rule 4.17.1(1). According to the permit file, the affected lands are located on Parcel number 8023000030. The name and address provided for the affected lands on the Division's Release Request form does not match the name and address for the parcel with the Larimer County Land Information site. Please provide the correct landowner information on the Release Request form. If the correct landowner information is not what is reflected with Larimer County, provide legal documentation showing the correct landowner information matching the information provided on the Division's Release Request form.

You have thirty (30) days from May 20, 2025, to submit all necessary documents that the Division needs for the application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the thirty-day period, the application has not been determined to be complete and filed, the Division may deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
