Mr. Garrison:

On September 6, 2024, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) performed a routine monitoring inspection of the Peat Mine, M1994-081. As a result of the inspection, the Division cited problems that require corrective action. The Division also issued Surety Increase (SI-2) on March 26, 2025.

The Operator has requested an extension to **June 13, 2025**, to complete the remaining corrective actions and submit SI-2. The Division hereby provides approval of an extension to this date.

Please note that if the corrective actions are not properly addressed and SI-2 is submitted, these outstanding items could be escalated to the level of possible violation and referred to the Mined Land Reclamation Board for further action.
