I. <u>General</u>

Colowyo Coal Company L.P. (Colowyo), Permit No. C-1981-019, is submitting this application for Phase I, II, and III performance bond release. Colowyo is requesting 1.8 acres be Phase I, II and III released with this application. The current bond amount for the Colowyo Mine is \$117,651,084.00. Colowyo currently holds a surety-bond in the amount of \$119,000,000.00. With this application, Colowyo will be requesting relinquishment of 60% of the base bond held for the Phase I, and 25% of the base bond held for the Phase II, and 100% of the base bond held for the Phase III area applied for under this application.

II. <u>Summary Information</u>

A. General Location Description

The 1.8 acres requested for Phase I, II, and III release are located within Moffat County, Colorado, in the following general location:

Township 3 North, Range 93 West of the 6th P.M.

Section 2 – SW ¹/₄ E ¹/₂ Section 2 – SE ¹/₄ NE ¹/₄ Section 11 – NW ¹/₄ NE ¹/₄

B. Public Notice

Pursuant to the Rules and Regulation of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board published August 1980, and pursuant to the Colorado Surface Coal Mining Reclamation Act 34-33-101, et seq., notice is hereby given of the filing of an application for Phase I through III Bond Release for 1.8 acres at the Colowyo Mine site. The application pertains to the existing Colowyo Coal Mine, Permit No. C-1981-019, Colowyo Coal Company L.P., 5731 State Highway No. 13, Meeker, Colorado 81641, filed with the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (CDRMS), Colorado Department of Natural Resources, 1313 Sherman Street, Room 215, Denver, Colorado 80203, and approved by the Division on February 27, 2023 (latest Permit Renewal). The Colowyo Mine is located approximately 28 miles south of Craig, Colorado.

The 1.8 acres of Phase I, II, and III bond release areas being applied for are a permanent structure (ditch) that will remain as constructed post mining. The area being applied for is shown on Map 1 within the application. Listed below is a general legal description of these areas:

Section 2 – SW ¹/₄ E ¹/₂ Section 2 – SE ¹/₄ NE ¹/₄ Section 11 – NW ¹/₄ NE ¹/₄ Colowyo currently holds a surety bond in the amount of \$119,000,000.00. With this application, Colowyo will be requesting relinquishment of 60% of the bond held for Phase I, and 25% of the bond held for Phase II, and 100% of the bond held for Phase III as applied for under the application.

III. <u>Summary of Reclamation and Management</u>

A. General Description

The area being applied for bond release is a conveyance channel (Streeter South Side Ditch). The structure will remain as a permanently post-mine in its current as-built configuration. The 1.8-acre area being applied for bond release is shown on Map 1.

The ten-year minimum bond liability period is not applicable for a sediment control structures that the reporting watershed has been Phase III released.

B. Topsoil Replacement

The applicability of Rule 4.06.4 does not apply to a permanent structure that is not being reclaimed.

C. Revegetation Success Demonstration

The applicability of Rule 4.15.8 does not apply to a permanent structure that is not being reclaimed.

D. Post-Mining Land Use

The surface landowners have requested to retain the Streeter South Side Ditch Pond as a permanent structure on their properties. Please refer to Exhibit 1B in Permit No. C-1981-008 for landowner letters requesting the Streeter South Side Ditch remain permanently.

The permanent Streeter South Side Ditch supports the post mine land use of wildlife and rangeland by providing a water conveyance structure and water source post-mine. The Streeter South Side Ditch is also heavily utilized by wildlife as is apparent by the game trails present on the structure.

E. Surface and Groundwater Impact Analysis

An analysis pertaining to surface and groundwater impacts does not apply to permanent structures (e.g. ditch).

IV. Notarized Statement

Pursuant to Rule 3.03.2(1)(e) each bond release application is required to provide a notarized statement that the reclamation activities have been accomplished in accordance with the requirements of the act and the approved reclamation plan.
